INDIANAPOLIS (May 2) -- The exhilarating world of Quarter-Scale Auto Club radio control racing is taking a new turn of the wheel in 2013.

WCM, the originator of the sport, is proud to become the title sponsor for the QSAC, National Championship Series. The Series will now be known as the QSAC National Championship Series presented by WCM. WCM is the oldest and largest builder of Quarter Scale Race cars in the world.

For this year, the schedule has grown with more contestants participating in races nationwide. With race day expenses in the tens of dollars instead of the thousands, Quarter Scale Racing is accessible to every race fan.

The six-race national event schedule takes the best of the QSAC racers to the limit of competition with five categories of cars, Sportsman, Limited Sportsman (Novice class), Super Truck, Super Late Model and Winged Sprint Car, offer these racers a perfect opportunity to display their driving, building and set up talents.

With the first race of the season in the books concluding in Marana, AZ, the next event on the WCM QSAC schedule will be at the DFW Speedway in Burleson, TX on May 24-25.

The tour peaks with the WCM QSAC showdown featuring the best radio-control racers from around the world at the Lagoon Park R/C Raceway in Montgomery, Alabama, in September followed by the Dirt Oval Nationals at a location to be announced in early October to end their competitive season.

“It’s a great way for racers with a limited budget to get really engaged with car racing,” said the series sponsor, WCM Co-Owner, Mark Hogue. “For around \$3,000, you can get a race-ready quarter-scale racecar with a full electronics package. All you have to do is flip the switch and you’re in business.”

The remaining races start with the running of the Indy 500 of WCM QSAC racing at Hoosier Racing Tire’s Newton Park in Lakeville, Indiana on June 21-22; followed by Machesney, Illinois on July 19-20, and wrapping up the regular season in Ingalls, Indiana on August 16-17.

“It’s a nationwide experience with dedicated radio-control racers that clearly want to race with the best QSAC racers and we’re fortunate to have such a high-level of people dedicated to the sport,” said Hogue. “It’s a perfect family experience that you will never outgrow the memories.”

“One of the really interesting things about this sport is the number of real race drivers and crew members that are involved, on any given day you may find yourself racing with some of the top names in motorsport” said Hogue.
